## ARTIST IN RESIDENCE PROGRAM

### Submission Guidelines

The **Artist in Residence** program supports any visual artist residing in northeast BC or a visual artist who is a member of an arts council supported by the Peace Liard Regional Arts Council (PLRAC) in developing and creating a body of work for a professionally curated exhibition. Artists must be Canadian Citizens, First Nations or Landed Immigrants (and able to work within Canada).

**Deadline to Apply:** ~~July 31, 2020~~ **Extended to August 15, 2020**

**Notification of Results:** September 15, 2020

#### **AIR Program Provides the Artist with the Following:**

1. Mentorship from a professional visual artist
2. Subsistence fee of \$2,000 for a four-week working period
3. Studio space if required
4. Professionally curated exhibit to be held at Peace Gallery North in Fort St. John August 2021 – artist will be paid the current CARFAC Exhibition Fee of \$2,027
5. Free admission to an artist talk/workshop by the AIR mentor ***available to all Peace-Liard Artists***

#### **Eligibility Guidelines:**

1. Artist must reside in northeast BC or be a member of an arts council supported by the Peace Liard Regional Arts Council.
2. Artist must not yet have had two or more professionally curated exhibitions for which they have received CARFAC exhibition fees.

#### **Application Guidelines:**

1. Curriculum Vitae (maximum three pages)
2. Description of proposed work intended for the residency (maximum one page)
3. Artist Bio and Statement (150 words maximum for each)
4. 5-10 images (a maximum of 1 MB file size each, jpeg format with a resolution of 72dpi at 1024 x 768 pixels) of recent work related to the residency proposal. Images must be labeled with a number\_title\_lastname (example: 01\_Nemo\_Smith).
5. Image List with image numbers, artist name, title of work and date, medium and dimensions

**How to Submit your Application:**

1. Send application by email attachments to [edplrac@gmail.com](mailto:edplrac@gmail.com) . Documents must be in Word or PDF format, and images in JPG format
2. Deadline for application is July 31, 2020

**Applications will be assessed by a jury according to the following criteria:**

**Artistic Merit**

- The artistic quality of your work
- The artistic rationale for your project
- The potential artistic outcomes

**Impact**

The potential of the project to:

- contribute to your artistic development
- advance your artistic practice

**Feasibility**

- Your capacity and experience to undertake the project
